Scout Show event information:

1. Scout Show officially opens at 9AM on Saturday and events may begin closing after 3PM.
2. No Ground fires allowed
3. Vehicles allowed to enter the fairgrounds area at 5:00PM on Friday but are not allowed to remain inside the fence once unloaded. Please use the parking area. Gates to fairgrounds area will open again on Saturday morning 7AM and remain open until 8:30AM for loading/unloading. The event gates open at 9:00AM and vehicles will need to be parked in the parking area after this time. Gates will open again for vehicles after 4PM for those not camping Saturday night. Please use the main parking entrance located on Sugarloaf Pkwy.
4. Main exhibit building will be closed after 4PM on Saturday.
5. Concession stand available ALL DAY Saturday from 9AM until 4PM.

7. Display booth/Exhibit space will be assigned upon arrival and check-in
8. Displays should exhibit activities, skills, interactive learning applicable to Scouting age youth (6-20)
9. Display operators/Vendors will not sell anything or conduct fundraising at the Scout Show
10. First Aid station will be located at the Main Exhibit Building entrance
