RULES and GENERAL INFORMATION

***All cars for Speed and Showmanship competitions must meet the
2010 Northeast Georgia Council Pinewood Derby OFFICIAL RULES***

LOCATION

Exhibit Hall at the Scout Blast on Saturday, April 17th, 2010 (Gwinnett County Fairgrounds)

WHO IS ELIGIBLE -- Each District can register up to a total of 12 winning cars.

1st, 2nd & 3rd place for Tiger Cub Speed and 1st, 2nd & 3rd place for Tiger Cub Showmanship
1st, 2nd & 3rd place for Cub Scout Speed and 1st, 2nd & 3rd place for Cub Scout Showmanship
(Cub Scouts are comprised of Wolves, Bears, Webelos-I & Webelos-II)

REGISTRATION -- SATURDAY, APRIL 17th from 9:00 am until 11:00 am ONLY!!!

Registration will be held at the Gwinnett County Fairgrounds Exhibit Hall

Cars must be registered either by the Cub Scout and parent or by the Cub Scout's Cubmaster. This Registration Form MUST accompany the car at registration and all information on the form, including signatures, must be completed in order to register. Council Registration will include an inspection and weigh-in procedure so be prepared in case you need to make any necessary adjustments to your car. At registration each car will be assigned a number. The number will be attached to the car on a small self-stick label. The number will help assist committee officials keep track of the car's progress and ownership. Once a car is registered, it will be retained by the race committee until after the competition and Trophy presentations have been completed.

All cars must be pre-registered in order to compete for Speed or Showmanship

COUNCIL RACE DAY SCHEDULE

Showmanship judging for Tigers & Cub Scouts will be completed Saturday morning after registration.

There will be separate Championship Speed races for Tiger Cub Scouts and Cub Scouts.

The Council **Tiger Cub race** will start Saturday morning, **April 17th, at 11:30 am.**

The Tiger Cub Scout race and Trophy presentation will take approximately 1 hour to complete.

Tiger Cub Scout Showmanship winners will be announced during the Trophy presentation.

The Council **Cub Scout race** will start afterwards at approximately **1:00 pm.**

The Cub Scout race and Trophy presentation will take approximately 1 hour to complete.

Cub Scout Showmanship winners will be announced during the Trophy presentation.

DURING THE RACE & REGISTRATION

The race areas and pit areas will be roped off and are off limits to everyone except race officials. Anyone else inside these areas will cause the car they are associated with to be disqualified from the competition.

The races will be held on an electrically timed track. Each car is run on each lane once with its time on each lane calculated by computer. After all of the cars have run on each lane once, each cars' time is averaged to determine the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winners. This eliminates any concerns about one lane being faster than another, since the cars are in effect running against the clock on each lane and being timed to one ten-thousandth of a second on each lane.
