Youth Protection Training

This is available on-line through National's Learning Center. This on-line presentation has audio available, and takes about an hour to complete. If you have a slow dial-up connection you may consider finding a high speed line to access it. At the end there will be a multiple choice test. Completion of the test successfully will then allow you to print out your card, receive a letter from Trip Selman, and also send record of your course completion to the Council training coordinator. You still may check out the video from the office or attend a live presentation when they are scheduled.

New Leaders Essentials and Leader Specific Training

This training is provided by the Apalachee District Training Committee at various times during the year. Scheduled training classed can be found on the Apalachee District Website (www.apalachee-bsa.org) in the Training section or on the calendar.

Introduction to Outdoor Skills

This training is provided by the Apalachee District Training Committee and is always offered in the fall of each year. A second spring course may be offered if needed. Many summer camps including Camp Rainey Mountain provide this training during summer camp. Scheduled training classed can be found on the Apalachee District Website (www.apalachee-bsa.org) in the Training section or on the calendar.

BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)

This training is providing by the Apalachee District Training Committee several times during the fall. All Cubs Scout outdoor activities require at least one leader to have this training. So it is very import for each Pack to have at least one leader complete this training. Scheduled training classed can be found on the Apalachee District Website (www.apalachee-bsa.org) in the Training section or on the calendar.
